**Dr. Shea stated that he was very unhappy about the report of the Faculty Senate Academic Standards & Policies Committee that went out on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Minoos explained that the report was based on the comments of the committee members. Dr. Shea stated that he believed that the comments came from one person only. Minoos explained that such an assumption was not the fact. The report was a combination of the comments by the committee members and based on the parliamentary procedures, unless a committee member goes on record, the discussions are reported collectively with no names attached to them.
