Concern about MBA being appropriate for Law Students who did not attend RWU or have business background. MBA was designed as a 4+1 program for RWU students.

Primary audience for this program will be Law Students who want some business background

Doesn't have a business plan attached for just this program, only have one for the MBA which is significantly different. Discussion of differences between programs and rigor of different programs. This is not a new degree, but adding electives to an existing program that opens it up to law students on campus. Have to be a student in good standing in the law school after one year to apply. Concern that as described the purpose of the proram and how it will work with the existing program. Is the program ready for this addition? Not clear as presented. Business is plan is the same one that was used when the MBA program was proposed and is three years old. Needs updating for the current proposal.
