***Motion (Moskowitz Alfieri): The FSAS&P Committee recommends that Faculty Senate creates a Faculty-Led Study Abroad Ad-hoc Committee to be charged with reviewing faculty-led study abroad program proposals offered under Special Topics 430, to serve as an advisory body for faculty-led study abroad programs, and to make recommendations, as needed, to the Global Spiegel Center to be further processed.***
